

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Regional Action Teams



Within the Coalition, there are six Regional Action Teams. Here is a description of each team's focus:

Aspiration/Preparation:

Access/Entry:

Data:

Experts and advocates focused on the identification, collection and codification of important and varied post-secondary statistics and information.
