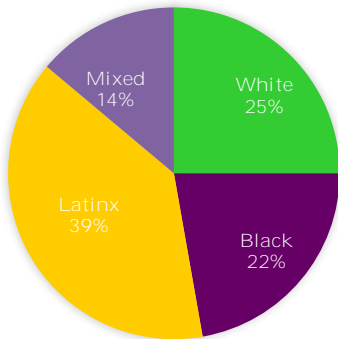

Why are we doing this project?

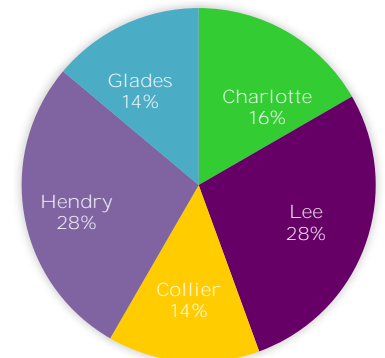
To understand **students'** attitudes and perceptions about their community and education

Students want to actively participate in contributing to the community.



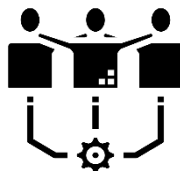
Students want to be exposed to local community leaders and their success stories.



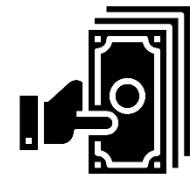
Students want access to life-skills courses to prepare them for adulthood.



Students would like to receive more support and encouragement.

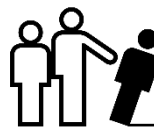


Students want to be equally exposed to local resources and opportunities.

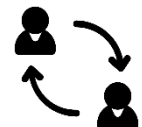


Students want their teachers to be paid more.
