

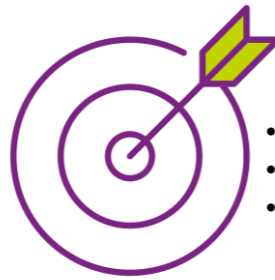

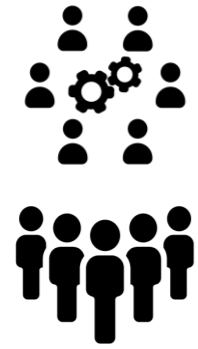

- Adults with incomplete degrees or certificates



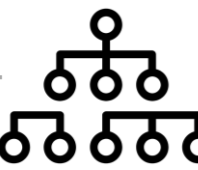
